The State Government, in December 2020, launched what has now become its flagship citizen-centric, welfare-oriented initiative "Duare Sarkar – Government at your Doorstep" along with its subprogramme "Paray Samadhan". The goal of this innovative development / governance initiative is to take all welfare schemes of the state government to the doorsteps of each citizen of the state with the objective of covering all eligible persons under the schemes.

The State has sought to improve the outcomes of Duare Sarkar by continuous innovation and adaptation whether in terms of increasing the number of schemes under its umbrella, process reengineering for simplifying access to the schemes, seamless, efficient, and effective implementation of the schemes as well as by improving the citizen's overall experience in the outreach camps by adding additional public amenities / conveniences as well as aspects including stakeholders participating in the campaign.

The outreach camps under Duare Sarkar have also evolved into the government's frontal grassroots information centres empowering citizens to get information and details of all schemes and their entitlements.

After 6 editions of the Duare Sarkar held so far, more than 4.66 Lakh community level Outreach camps have been conducted, resulting in the delivery of more than 7.19 Crore services to eligible citizens throughout the state.
